AGENDA

The agenda for the Annual General Meeting will be:

- 1. To receive the minutes of the 2022 Annual General Meeting
- 2. To receive the Annual Reports and audited financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2023
- 3. To elect Office Bearers: President, two Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer and three Councillors (refer below for nomination procedures)
- 4. To appoint the Auditor
- 5. The following special resolutions will be proposed:
 - a. To replace the rules of the Windsor and District Historical Society Inc. that were adopted on 7 April 1991 with the updated rules as submitted to this Annual General Meeting.
 - b. To lodge the new rules with the Office of Fair Trading for approval and acceptance accompanied by the required lodgement fee.

The proposed new rules are attached to this newsletter.

Please note the following:

- Under Clause 27 of the existing rules, changes to the rules must be passed by a special resolution at a general meeting. The changed rules do not come into effect until approval of the changes is received via Queensland Office of Fair Trading.
- A special resolution of an association means a resolution passed at a general meeting of the association by the votes of three-quarters of the members who are present and entitled to vote on the resolution.
- 6. Any other business of which proper notice has been given

NOMINATIONS for positions on the MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE – Form attached

In accordance with Clause 11(3) of the Society's Rules of Incorporation any two financial members of the Society may nominate any other financial member to serve as an officer or other member of the Management Committee.

The nomination must be in writing and signed by the member, proposer and seconder and lodged with the Secretary at least 14 days before the Annual General Meeting. Nominations can be mailed or hand delivered to the Chambers and will be displayed on the notice board at the Chambers for at least seven days immediately preceding the Annual General Meeting.

Where there is no effective candidate nominated to fill a position, nominations for that position shall be taken from the floor.
